

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR CANDIDATE : CRET-2019

1. **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR CRET-2019** : The candidate must have passed the Master's Degree in the relevant discipline with minimum 55% marks or equivalent grade scale and also must have secured IInd division marks or equivalent grade scale at Bachelor's Degree level exam. Reservation policy of State/Central Govt. will be followed.
2. A Relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer) Differently-Abled and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission for the relevant year, or for those who had obtained their Master's degree prior to 19th September, 1991. The eligibility marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible based only on the qualifying marks without including the grace mark procedures.
3. **PATTERN OF CRET** : The test will consist of one paper of 100 marks having two parts. **Part-A** [General Awareness] will consist of 30 objective questions related to General Knowledge, Research Aptitude, Computer Awareness, General English and Reasoning. **Part-B** will consist of 70 objective questions covering the areas of subject. All questions carry 02 marks each. To qualify a candidate must obtain 100 marks i.e. 50% . A 5% relaxation will be granted for candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC(Non-Creamy layer)/Differently-abled category or other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission for the relevant year
4. **Application form without mandatory (asterisk "*" marked) information is liable to be rejected.**
5. The actual admission is subject to availability of vacancies and suitable supervisors. adhering to UGC Ph.D. regulations 2016, and amendments from time to time strictly in all matters.

Note : The streams for research are subject to addition or alternation at the discretion of the **Deemed to be University**

7. **Criteria for proposing merit position in each subject to CRET-2019 as below:**

1. To qualify for merit the candidate should have secured a minimum 50% marks in the entrance exam. A 5% relaxation will be allowed for candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC(Non-Creamy layer)/Differently-abled category or other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission for the relevant year.

2. For Final selection of Candidate for admission, a weightage of 70% of the Entrance test and 30% in the performance in the interview/Viva-voce shall be given. Other Conditions of the UGC [Minimum standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph.D. Degrees] Regulations, 2016 remains the same.

8. The examination will be conducted on **22-09-2019 (Sunday) w.e.f. 9 am to 11 am at Jamunipur campus**. For any change or alternative information, the interested candidate are advised to visit website of the deemed to be University i.e., www.ngbu.edu.in.

9. **Any other matter that may arise, will be decided by the deemed to be University and will be binding on candidates.**
